

Naming your Computer Files

- Examples:
 - yy_mm_dd_complete_descriptive_title_mauricio_gonzalez
 - yymmdd_completedescriptivetitle_mauriciogonzalez
 - yymmdd_complete_descriptive_title_mauricio_gonzalez
- Reason:
 - All popular computer OS will recognize this format including UNIX

Naming your Computer Files

- When you send me an assignment file you must add your name to the original file name.
- Examples:
 - yy_mm_dd_complete_descriptive_title_mauricio_gonzalez
 - yymmdd_completedescriptivetitle_mauriciogonzalez
 - yymmdd_complete_descriptive_title_mauricio_gonzalez
- Notice:
 - That I use lower case letters. This generally makes things easier to read.

Activity

• Open up your Scientific Method Stick lab report you saved on to your thumb drive.

Open up Windows explorer

- Right click on the "My Computer" icon on the "Desk Top."
- Left click on "Explore."
- Navigate to your thumb drive on the left hand side explorer window.
- It might be called "removable drive e:"
- You should see the file on the right hand side explorer window.

Activity

- Rename the file using the method I taught you.
 - One way of renaming your file is to "Save as."
 - Another way is to click on the file once and then press the F2 key.
 - A third way is to click on the file once, wait, then click on it again.
 - A fourth way is to right click on a file and then press "rename."

- DO NOT press the power key to shut down.
- DO NOT close the screen to shut down.
