

Saving Files in Microsoft Word

- Under the "File" menu click on "Save As"
- In the "Save As" dialog box click the "Save In" drop down menu and search for your drive letter and name.
- Click on your drive and navigate to the MBRP folder (if you don't have one create one).

Saving Files in Microsoft Word


- Save it with the same procedure of Naming your Computer Files.
- Hit "Save" and it will be saved on that drive in your specific folder.





Create folders to organize your USB thumb drives.

- WINXP On your desktop you may have a "My Computer" icon that you should right click and left click on "Explore." If not, this icon is under the "Start" menu.
- In later versions of windows you can find "Explore" in "Computer" under the "Start" menu.
- Find "Explore on your computer.


- In "Explore" find your USB thumb drive as you were taught previously.
- Left click on your drive so it is highlighted.
- Go to File > New > Folder and this will create a new folder.
- Rename your folder "MBRP" for my class.








- There may be a situation when you want to create a folder while you are saving a file.
- For example, when you are saving data using MS WORD go to the "save as" function you learned previously.
- There will be a folder icon on the top menu with a star on its top-right corner.
- Once you're in the correct folder or drive you can left click on this icon and it will create a new folder.
